

REPORTABLE COMMUNICABLE DISEASES IN MONTANA

Report suspected or confirmed cases by **calling 258-3896** or **faxing: 258-3610**
24/7 immediate reporting: call 9-1-1
 Ask for the "Health Department's Infectious Disease On-Call staff"

All Montana health care providers are required to report patients diagnosed with the conditions below to their local health department. This reporting falls within HIPAA medical privacy exceptions for release of information. Reporting patients with the conditions below does not require patient consent. Reporting enables public health officials to conduct follow-up on cases of significance, and to identify outbreaks or emerging health concerns. Duplicate reports are not a problem.
