You are encouraged to learn more about the prospective Air Pollution Control regulations and to share your thoughts with the Air Pollution Control Board. This Air Board is responsible for making changes to the Air Regulations. It will hold one or more public hearings, and consider written and oral comments, before adopting any changes.

The proposed regulations will be heard by the Air Pollution Control Board first and then reviewed by and subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners, City Council, and state Board of Environmental Review.
