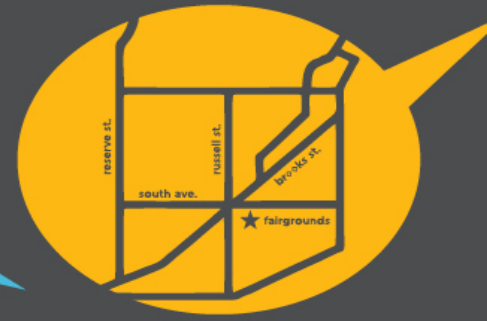


still need to register to vote in the city's mail ballot election?

head to the missoula county fairgrounds
use the south avenue entrance and follow the signs.
take the #1 or #7 bus.

The Elections Office moved its late voter registration services and counting center from the Missoula County Courthouse to the Missoula County Fairgrounds.

Why?

The space required to run elections has grown and requires more room to ensure security and provide quality customer service. The fairgrounds location finally gives voters and staff the room they need to participate in the electoral process. There is more parking, too! You can also access the fairgrounds on the #1 or #7 buses.

Where?

The Elections Center is located in the Fine Arts Building at the fairgrounds. Use the South Avenue entrance and follow the signs.

When?

The Elections Office will provide all late and same-day voter registration services at the fairgrounds for every election cycle for the city's upcoming mail ballot election, and all elections in the foreseeable future. Elections staff will be available at the fairgrounds from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday October 6th through November 2nd. The Elections Center is open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day, November 3rd.

What is late voter registration?

Missoula County Residents who have not yet registered to vote by 5 p.m. on the 30th day before an election can take advantage of late voter registration and same day voter registration.

How do I know if I'm registered?

You can call the Missoula County Elections Office at 258-4751 or visit <http://app.mt.gov/voterinfo/> to find out if you're registered to vote in Missoula County.

What is a mail ballot election?

A mail ballot election requires the elections office mail a ballot to every active registered voter in Missoula County 15 days prior to Election Day. Ballots will be mailed on October 19th. If you are an active registered voter and live within the city limits and haven't received a ballot by October 22nd, call the Elections Office at 258-4751. If you register late before the 19th, your ballot will be mailed to you. If you register after October 19th, you'll receive your ballot at the fairgrounds. You can either vote your ballot at the fairgrounds, or take it home and complete it there.

What is an active voter?

To be considered an active voter, you must have cast a ballot in the last federal election.
