This is to advise you that on November 6, 2006, the citizens of Missoula County passed an initiative to make adult marijuana offenses the lowest law enforcement priority, to set up a citizens committee to monitor the effects of this policy, and to request that the federal and Montana state governments do the same. Subsequently, on March 21, 2007, the Missoula County Commissioners amended the initiative to make it apply only to adult misdemeanor marijuana offenses. The original and amended versions of such initiative are attached for your information.
