## **MISSOULA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' OFFICE MOVES THIS WEEK**

The Missoula County Commissioners' Office is set to move across the street this week to Missoula County's new administrative building at 199 West Pine Street. The Commissioners' Office is the fourth department to move into the new building, following the Facilities Management, Information Services and Financial Services departments. The Surveyor and Geographic Information Systems, Human Resources, and County Auditor's offices will move to the administrative building in the coming weeks. All of the administrative departments are expected to be in the new building by the end of the year.

The County Commissioners will host an open house event around the New Year to officially welcome the public to the new building. "We're excited about hosting an open house, but we'd like to extend an invitation to anyone who'd like to visit us sooner," says Commission Chair Jean Curtiss. "We want to make sure the public feels welcome to stop in and say 'hi' even while we are settling in."

The Missoula County Courthouse and Annex will continue to house the following departments: Motor Vehicle/Treasurer, Recording and Elections, Justice Court, Clerk of Court, the Sheriff's Office, the County Attorney's Office, and District Court.
