

2. Hearing on Application to Dissolve or Modify Preliminary Injunction: The Hearing on Imperial Oil's Application to Dissolve or Modify Preliminary Injunction is set for **Thursday, September 22, 2011 at 1:30 p.m.**, in the Missoula County Courthouse, Missoula, Montana.

3. Discovery Deadline: Discovery Requests shall be served on or before the discovery deadline of October 21, 2011.

4. Motions Deadline: On or before **November 4, 2011**, the parties shall file all motions and opening briefs. All responsive briefs shall be filed pursuant to Rule 2 of the Uniform District Court Rules.


5. Hearing on Motions: A hearing will be held by this Court on all pending motions on **Friday, January 20, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.**, in the Courtroom at the Missoula County Courthouse, Missoula, Montana.

6. Trial Date: The Trial shall commence before the Court, sitting without a jury, on **Monday, April 23, 2012, at 9:30 a.m.**, first setting, in the **Courtroom at the Missoula County Courthouse in Missoula, Montana**. The Court shall conduct a conference with the attorneys prior to the start of trial at 9:00 a.m. Five (5) days have been reserved on the Court calendar for said trial.

SCHEDULING ORDER MODIFICATIONS AND SANCTIONS

Pursuant to Rule 16(b) and 16(c) of Montana Rules of Civil Procedure, the foregoing schedule shall not be modified except by leave of court upon a showing of good cause. Pursuant to Rule 16(f) of Montana Rules of Civil Procedure, counsel and parties shall be prepared to actively and effectively participate in and complete all specified pretrial activities and shall do so in good faith. Any failure by parties, whether collectively or individually, to timely and strictly comply with terms of this order may subject offending parties and counsel to sanctions pursuant to Rule 16(f) of Montana Rules of Civil Procedure. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this order shall not be modified unless the Court finds that the interests of justice so require.
