MISSOULA COUNTY PROVIDES IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR NOVEMBER 2ND ELECTION

The Elections Center at the Fairgrounds will extend its hours on Saturday, October 30th to assist voters from 8 a.m. until 1 p.m. Citizens can register to vote, receive an absentee ballot or return their ballot during these additional hours. The Elections Center will also be open for late registration and absentee voting Monday, October 25th through Friday, October 29th from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. at the Fairgrounds. Mountain Line busses 1 and 7 serve the Missoula County Fairgrounds.

The Missoula County Elections' Office reminds voters that absentee voting and late registration closes at noon on Monday, November 1st and reopens on Election Day, November 2nd, from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Absentee Ballots must be received by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 2nd. Voters can mail their ballots or drop them off at one of three locations: the Missoula County Courthouse, the Elections Center at the Fairgrounds, or at a polling place on Election Day.

Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, November 2nd. Identification is required to receive a ballot. If you are unsure of your polling location, please visit our website, www.co.missoula.mt.us/election, and try Missoula County's new Interactive Voter Information Map.
