ABSENTEE VOTING, LATE VOTER REGISTRATION BEGINS MONDAY, OCTOBER 4TH

Missoula County Elections Administrator Vickie Zeier reminds voters about the upcoming general election on November 2nd. Voters registered to vote absentee should look for their ballots in the mail starting next week. Voters who are not signed up to vote absentee, but would like to vote before November 2nd can visit the Elections Center at the Missoula County Fairgrounds to cast their ballot. Voters can also mail a written request for an absentee ballot to the Elections Office at 200 W. Broadway, Missoula, MT 59802. The request should include their name, birth date, and address of where to mail the ballot. The Elections Center is serviced by Mountain Line Bus Routes 1 and 7. Missoula County residents not yet registered to vote can visit the Elections Center to register to vote and receive a ballot. The Elections Center also provides an Automark to assist voters with disabilities in marking their ballots. Due to space limitations, ballots are not kept or disseminated at the Missoula County Courthouse downtown.

Absentee voters can use the County's online ballot tracking system at <http://www.co.missoula.mt.us/Election/> to check the status of their ballot. Candidate lists and financial campaign reports are also available on the Elections Office website.
