MISSOULA COUNTY RELEASES PLANNING PROCESS AND SCHEDULE FOR MACLAY BRIDGE

The Missoula County Commissioners and Public Works Department have released a preliminary planning process and schedule regarding Maclay Bridge. “We know people in that area of the County have questions about the future of Maclay Bridge,” says Commission Chair Jean Curtiss. “Any discussion at Missoula County about the bridge generates a lot of interest, and we wanted to centralize that information and let folks know that the planning process hasn’t started yet. When it does, there will be plenty of opportunities for public involvement. We know how important this bridge is and we want to assure area residents that they’ll be involved in the discussions about it.”

“We’re quite a ways out from initiating the planning process for Maclay Bridge, but I wanted to piece together a time line for residents interested in the process,” says County Public Works Director, Greg Robertson. “We may not have all the answers yet, but we’ll have a process that makes sure residents are involved.”
