MISSOULA COUNTY PREPARES FOR MOBILE HOME SALE

The Missoula County Treasurer's Office is preparing for a mobile home sale to be conducted on Tuesday, October 19th, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 201 of the Missoula County Courthouse Annex at 200 West Broadway. There are 320 delinquent mobile homes that will be offered for sale if the taxes are not paid. The owners of the mobile homes have until the time of the sale to pay the delinquent taxes, penalty, interest and costs to remove them from the sale. Montana Code Annotated 15-16-401 provides that, "The judgment is not satisfied nor the lien removed until the taxes are paid or the property sold for the payment of the taxes."

Missoula County Clerk & Recorder/Treasurer, Vickie Zeier, encourages people with delinquent taxes to contact her office. "It's a tough time for some property owners right now. If someone is behind in paying their taxes, we may be able to work with them to figure out a payment plan."
