Thank you for your interest in the Missoula County Schools.

Our office is involved in the processing of applications for the Missoula County rural schools. Three of these schools are within commuting distance from Missoula; Swan Valley is not. All four rural schools receive services from the Missoula Area Education Cooperative.

POTOMAC DISTRICT #11

Potomac is located approximately 20 miles east of Missoula, just off Highway 200. This is the largest of our rural schools with approximately 100 students.

SUNSET DISTRICT #30

Sunset School employs one teacher for grades K-8. Currently 1 student is enrolled. Sunset is located about 30 miles east of Missoula in the community of Greenough off Highway 200.

SWAN VALLEY DISTRICT #33

Swan Valley Elementary School is on the border of the Bob Marshall Wilderness and Mission Range. The school is north of Seeley Lake on Highway 83, approximately 75 miles from Missoula. The school has about 30 students.

WOODMAN DISTRICT #18

Woodman School has approximately 50 students. It is located about 20 miles southwest of Missoula, west of Lolo on Highway 12.
